What is *ele.IT*?

ele.IT is an exam certifying a non native basic competence in Italian for foreigners who wish to measure the level of knowledge attained. The competence required is equivalent to level **B1**, that is the level described as “**threshold user**” by *Common European Framework of Reference* (<http://www.coe.int>): “*ability to express oneself in a limited way in familiar situations and to deal in a general way with non-routine information*” (p. 250).

How is the *ele.IT* exam structured?

ele.IT consists of 4 modules, to be taken together in one session:

1. **Listening** (comprehension of short oral texts);
2. **Reading** (comprehension of short written texts);
3. **Italian language use and usage** (Comprehension of everyday uses of Italian and production of short and simple written texts);
4. **Speaking** (interaction on topics regarding everyday life)

Who is *ele.IT* useful for?

ele.IT can be useful for:

- **students** who wish to enroll in Italian universities;
- **people** interested in working in an Italian language context;
- **adults** interested in Italian language and culture.

When and where can the *ele.IT* exam be taken?

May 9, 2009. It takes place in **Italy** and **abroad** at the **Italian Cultural Institutes** or at other **authorized Institutions**.

How much does *ele.IT* cost?

The fee depends on the region. For example, in UE, Japan and USA is € 80,00.
