History and Values

1 Roma Tre University is a **young university thought for young people**. Founded in 1992, it has rapidly grown both in terms of students and courses offered. It has gained an excellent rating among the most prominent academic rankings, especially within the younger universities.

Roma Tre University is organized in 13 departments offering [Bachelor's degrees](#), [Postgraduate and Advanced courses](#), [PhDs](#) and [Specialisation Schools](#).

A dynamic, modern and international university that has been immediately identified as the vital lever of the urban development of the capital, within which it is now deeply rooted, contributing in changing the city's identity with a persevering process of restructuring and re-using abandoned industrial buildings, converting them into factories of knowledge and research.

2 Among its founding values, Roma Tre assumes the **promotion and organization of high-quality international research**, the **excellence in advanced education** as well as in the **development and dissemination of knowledge**, the **environmental protection**, the **international solidarity**, the principles of gender equity and the evaluation and recognition of merit.

Teaching and research, in all disciplinary areas, constantly interact and target a global world, thus promoting the upgrading and enrichment of knowledge; they combine their action with the third mission, considered both as technology transfer and as a projection of advanced education activities on the territory.

3 The international dimension is considered a strategic aspect for the University, which adheres, among others, to the inspirational principles of the Magna Charta Universitatum and identifies itself in the principles and tools of the European Research and advanced education Area.

Quality Assurance – QA

Roma Tre University has adopted a Quality Assurance System (QA) in line with the 'AVA' Self-assessment, Periodic Assessment and Accreditation guidelines, approved by the National University and Research Assessment Agency (ANVUR) and with the European Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the European Higher Education Area (ESG).

4 The university has taken steps aimed at the planning, monitoring and assessment of course catalogue, research and third mission in order to achieve continuous improvement of quality standards, as indicated in the Quality Manual approved by the university's Governing Bodies.

The [Governing Bodies](#), the [Quality Office](#) and the [Assessment Unit](#) guarantee the implementation of valuable processes to assure the quality of the university's activities.

Departments and Schools

Roma Tre University is organized in:

- **13 Departments** that manage, coordinate, plan and promote scientific research as well as teaching and training activities. Departments are responsible for carrying on the development of the following functions:
 - research;
 - teaching and training activities related to Bachelor's and Master's degrees as well as PhDs;
 - other educational activities;
 - external activities related to research and teaching or aimed at enhancing and disseminating the activities and competences of the Departments themselves, including partnership, spin-off and start-up initiatives.

5 Two or more departments can submit to the Academic Senate the proposal of setting up a school, owing the function to coordinate and rationalise teaching activities.

- **1 School** that provides high organisational and qualitative standards and ensures the perfect sustainability of study programmes, coordinates the teaching programming guidelines and the proposals for activating specific courses in the departmental academic offer. They also give advice and remarks concerning teaching staff recruitment, assessing the compatibility and functionality of recruitment proposals in relation to teaching planning and academic offer.

Libraries

The University Library System (SBA) offers qualified resources and services in teaching and research, thus meeting the information needs of the university community. The library system is divided into eight specialised libraries that collect documentary heritage belonging to related disciplines.

6 Some libraries are organised into sections located in the various university premises and conceived in order to be as close as possible to students and professors. It also hosts the literary heritage of the Italo Latin American Institute, that is partly available in Economics and Political Studies library.

The University Library System provides over 950,000 paper documents, electronic and digital documents, and it is constantly updated in order to offer the most advanced IT resources.

Research Agency

Roma Tre University envisages the central role of research for the advancement of knowledge and the achievement of significant scientific, cultural, social and economic objectives. In this sense it considers research as a primary function, fostering its development as well as its essential connection with teaching.

7 Roma Tre Students are therefore surrounded by a high-level international research environment that contributes, at each step of their study programme, to encourage and develop their skills.

Roma Tre promotes and supports basic research in all its scientific-disciplinary areas, enhancing its original and innovative contents. Roma Tre also promotes applied research focused on the development and transfer of new technologies, always respecting the aims and responsibilities deriving from its public nature.

The Research Agency was established in April 2018 with the aim of pursuing those objectives. The Agency consists of two offices: the [National Research Office](#) and the [European and International Research Office](#).

8 The Research Agency ensures an integrated and efficient advisory system, management and professional support, for the Departments and academic community, necessary for the administration, improvement and enhancement of the research activities through promotional activities, counselling, editing management and support, project dealing and management, both planning and implementation stage, in the reporting and internal audit of financed contracts, as well as information activities and updating regarding new opportunities and funding models in European and international fields.

The Agency also provides its support in the administrative proceedings about PhDs and Phd Schools of the Departments, on the research fellowships procedures, on the Research Repository management and during the submission of National and Regional projects.
